BA DEGREE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**

Step I – Earn an AA or AS degree from Rio Hondo College (62 Units)

The degree can be in any discipline. However, the following are recommended for preparation for the ULV's Bachelor's in Business Administration:

- Small Business
- Retail Management*
- International Business*
- Accounting
- Business Administration
- Business Management
- Computer Information Technology

* Currently offered as certificates. Approval pending as AA degree programs.

Step II – Complete additional courses (22 Units) –

1. Math 120 or Math 170 (3 units)
2. Math 130 (3 units)
3. 16-19 Units of Supplemental Courses – Can be any transferable Rio Hondo units. However, to add breadth and depth to the Bachelor's degree in Business Administration it is recommended the student choose transferable courses from the following areas: Business Administration, Accounting, Small Business/Entrepreneurialism, Computer Information Technology, English Writing, Speech, or courses dealing with cross-cultural issues. **MGMT 101, Introduction to Business is highly recommended.** A ULV academic advisor will help you develop an individualized degree plan.
4. Prerequisites for the BA in Business Administration degree – If your AA degree is not in Business Administration, then the following courses must be included as part of the 16-19 units listed in item 3 above: ACCT 101, ACCT 102, ECON 101 and ECON 102.

Step III – University of La Verne Courses (44 Units – 11 classes)

ECBU 330, Business Finance

ECBU 347, Legal Environment of Business

ECBU 350, Principles of Management

ECBU 360, Principles of Marketing

ECBU 410, Management of Information Technology

ECBU 496, Business Seminar

12 Units (3 classes) of Upper Division Business Electives – this will depend on the courses the cohort of students may be interested in taking

CORE 300, Values and Critical Thinking

One additional 4-unit upper division course

Total of 128 Units required for the ULV Business Administration degree

AA Degree Transfer: At the time of matriculation, admitted and enrolled students who have earned an associate degree from Rio Hondo College and who followed the IGETC, CSU, or UC transfer curriculum, will be credited with fulfilling all of ULV's General Education **AREA** Requirements. If a student did not follow one of these GE transfer curriculums, they may be lacking some ULV GE AREA requirements. Students will fulfill ULV's GE **CORE** Requirements through the eleven (11) courses to be offered on-site at Rio Hondo College.
